Fact By eight weeks, the "little one" has developed every organ found in an adult and is even sucking his or her thumb

Fact At five months, although you can legally abort me, I could survive outside my mother's womb

A. 15-25%

Q. What percentage of women in U.S. seek to adopt a child?

A. 5%

Q. What percentage of pregnancies in the U.S. end in abortion?

A. 22%

I have personally been honored to serve as a Birthright volunteer for the past twenty-eight years and have experienced many life-changing opportunities to make a difference in the lives of many grateful people. In return I have gained a great deal of understanding as well as a genuine compassion for the women and girls who have sought assistance while facing the toughest times of their lives. Many of these girls have fallen into a trap in believing that they must abort their unborn children in order to continue on with their lives. 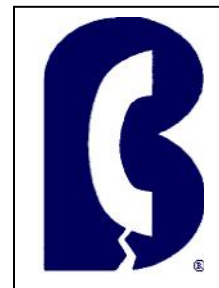
